



Beverley Fauna Surveys

EBS undertook a large fauna survey at Beverley, approximately 600km north of Adelaide. Beverley is situated on the arid plains of South Australia between the Northern Flinders Ranges and Lake Frome.

EBS was selected to complete the survey and to ascertain the likely impacts of a proposed mine expansion on fauna species and fauna habitat in the area. EBS utilised fauna survey methods to detect the presence of mammals, birds, reptiles and amphibians inhabiting the surrounding area. An assessment of possible and likely impacts was undertaken as part of the project.

Since the initial survey investigations, EBS has been involved in annual monitoring at Beverley to obtain comparative data of fauna found to determine any impacts by mining operations. The annual monitoring at 20 sites is undertaken each spring with the data collected reviewed each year.
